



C is for CHAMPIONS

IN THE STORY THE AUTHOR WRITES ABOUT WHAT BEING A CHAMPION IS ABOUT IN THE GAME OF LIFE, AND BASEBALL. USING THE SAME FORMAT AS THE AUTHOR, USE EACH LETTER IN THE WORD C.H.A.M.P.I.O.N. TO WRITE ABOUT A TIME IN YOUR LIFE WHERE IN THE END YOU TOO WERE A...CHAMPION.

LESSON ACTIVITY: WRITING- Write a sentence that uses each letter in the word champion to describe a time where something you did was represented by trait of the letter.

C is for courage- write a sentence describing a time when you demonstrated an act of *courage*.

H is for honesty- write a sentence describing a time when you demonstrated an act of *honesty*.

A is for ability- write a sentence describing something you have the *ability* to do that makes you unique.

M is for motivation- write a sentence describing a time when you were *motivated* by someone, or a time when you *motivated* someone else.



P is for positivity- write a sentence about a *positive* experience, or *positive* person in your life.

I is for integrity- write a sentence describing a time when you demonstrated an act of *integrity*.

O is for opportunity- write a sentence describing an *opportunity* that you have experienced that led to success.

N is for never- write a sentence describing a time when you did *not quit* at something, even though you felt as if you wanted to.

S is for success- describe a moment, or time when you did something that led to a *successful* outcome.
